Applying for visa for the purpose of studies

Required documents

1 passport-size color **photos** (not older than 6 months, with white background)

Valid passport + copy of the photo page

Green card or US visa (if you are not US citizen) + copy

Health insurance (original to show) + a copy

A valid and booked **plane ticket** to Hungary

Acceptance letter- that combines your:

certificate of school attendance for the study abroad semester

Accommodation (dormitory, leasing agreement, hotel reservation, etc.)

Home (US) University School certificate of attendance

2 completed forms:

Application for residence permit

Inset 14 (or the purpose of studies or student mobility)

Bank statement proving that you have enough money to cover your stay *(must not be older than 30 days)*

Optional supporting documentation1: declaration from parents that they bear the costs or pay if the student for some reason is running out from his/her budget. Needs to be signed and dated by the parent with blue ink.

Optional supporting documentation2: bank statement of one of the parents

Prepaid, self-addressed envelope (Fedex, UPS)

OR ask for a personal pick-up

71 USD - cash!

This visa will give you permission to enter Hungary and the Schengen Zone once for a maximum of 30 days! Once in Budapest you will need to continue the procedure in order to obtain your residence permit, which should be done within a maximum of 30 days upon your arrival!

Important note – know your mother's maiden name:

It is the surname/birth name the student's mother had before she married and took the student's father's name. (An example of a maiden name is Jones for a woman who was named Sarah Jones before she married and became Sarah Stein.)
